













The undersigned members of the Council of Church Universities and Colleges agree to work together for the following ends:

- 1) the exploration, development and enhancement of Christian principles in higher education in a diverse and inclusive society which includes those of other faiths or of no faith

- 6) responding to issues of public concern and interest from the perspective of a Christian foundation
- 7) mutual support.
